HOPE and CARE for Children

Is an independent non-governmental organization serving the most vulnerable people of Liberia: orphans, children, women & widows.

MISSION: *Demonstrating God's love by giving hope to HIS children*

HISTORY: Faith Community Lutheran Church in Las Vegas, NV began sponsoring 9 orphans in Wenzon, Liberia in 2009. In spring of 2014, 9 more orphans were rescued from vulnerable and extremely desperate situations. Then flooding displaced the orphans and the care-giving families out of their home. Months later, Ebola became a major influence not only in health but in every aspect of life for Liberians: economy, educational, social, mental and emotional. Liberia dropped to the rank of the 3rd poorest nation in the world. In August, 2016 the HOPE family moved into the newly constructed orphanage home in Joezohn community through a Lutheran school, church and orphanage home.

TODAY: As of January, 2018 there are 31 orphans in our HOPE family. HOPE Lutheran School had 290 students enrolled in the 17-18 school year Prek-6th grade. In September, 2018 the high school wing grades 7-12 will open.

WHAT NEXT: HOPE and CARE Medical Center

The orphans, students, and the community need a medical center on campus. Liberia does not have good medical care. The nearest medical clinic is 10 miles away from the orphanage/school and neighborhood. 99% of parents at HOPE Lutheran School do not own a car.

HOW CAN YOU HELP? It will cost \$40,000 to construct the medical center. We need your financial support to build this medical center. If a child gets sick or injured at school it is our duty to be able to treat them. As a good neighbor we want to offer quality healthcare to our neighbors.

People die every day, simply due to a lack of access to healthcare. Most of them are children and elderly. We want to offer hope and healing in Jesus' name.
